Rendezvous Bistro

If there's one name to know in the Jackson Hole culinary community, it's Gavin Fine. The Tetons' answer to Danny Meyer, Fine reigns over his seven-restaurant fine-dining empire, which ranges from the town's primary wine bar, Bin 22, to Teton Village's "Bodega," a roadside market-cum-Dean and DeLuca, and the flagship Rendezvous Bistro, which he opened 15 years ago at the ripe old age of 25.

Bar Enoteca (Teton Village)

Bar Enoteca, which opened in October of 2017, is the newest restaurant from the "Fine Dining" Group. Located next to its sister restaurant **Il Villaggio Osteria** inside the Hotel Terra, Bar Enoteca focuses on lighter Italian fare and wine. Head chef Serge Smith (also Executive Chef of Osteria) presents European-style small plates like Mojama (salt-cured tuna) with olive oil and hazelnuts and house-made head cheese.
