Helmed by executive chef Joe Boyles, <u>The Kitchen</u> offers a unique spin on Asian cuisine. Think: sticky rice tamales, elk pho, and—perhaps most notably—shrimp and grits.

The Cloudveil, right on the Town Square, is the epitome of convenience, with shuttles to and from the mountain and complimentary snack stations on each floor. Part of the Autograph Collection of hotels, the luxury property has 100 guest rooms and suites, along with its own restaurant, The Bistro, an outdoor pool and hot tub, and live music in the lobby. In case you were curious, the name is a tribute to the Cloudveil Dome in the Tetons, and can be seen in the painting above by a local artist.
