Well Traveled: A Ski Trip to Jackson Hole, Wyoming

The hotel's in-house restaurant is The Bistro. Serving elevated yet approachable food with a French flair, it's part of the plainly named Fine Dining Restaurant Group (FDRG), a prominent hospitality collective in Jackson. For breakfast at The Bistro, fuel up before hitting the slopes with the eatery's Heavenly Quiche (spinach, onion, bacon, gruyère) or tarte flambée (lemon crème fraîche, bacon lardons, caramelized onions, brie, arugula, and fried eggs)—and be sure to order a basket of huckleberry scones.

For dinner, start with the jumbo shrimp appetizer (the cocktail sauce has a light kick), then try the scrumptious coq au vin or crispy duck confit. Save room for the decadent bread pudding, made with croissants and topped with ice cream and warm chocolate sauce.
