

TODAY: Jackson chef represents Wyoming in national TV special

Gavin Fine of Fine Dining Restaurant Group in Jackson Hole will represent the state of Wyoming for a special Thanksgiving week feature of the Today Show, "United Plates of Thanksgiving."

Featuring 52 recipes from 52 chefs from across the country, the Today Show is celebrating "all the flavors of America" in what producers are billing as the morning show's "biggest Thanksgiving event ever."
