## Jackson, Wyoming

Nestled in the spectacular Jackson Hole valley, Jackson, Wyoming, is the perfect winter getaway. With the towering Grand Tetons and Yellowstone National Park just a short drive to the north, it's the gateway to a wonderland of outdoor adventures. But even if your idea of a snow day involves cozying up by the fire with a cup of cocoa, Jackson has plenty to offer. Modus Operandi: At barely a year old, this cozy bar and bottle shop has already established itself as the place in town for wine drinkers. Local restaurateur Gavin Fine was inspired to open the rustic-chic downtown spot by his travels through Italy, where he often enjoyed meals in local shops with a great bottle, some cheese and charcuterie, Bin22 offers hundreds of wines by the bottle, including some under their own label, as well as by-the-glass options, beer from Fine's Roadhouse Brewing and a terrific whiskey selection—the star of which is Wyoming Whiskey from the state's first legal distillery, which opened in late 2012.
