The 13 Best Hotels in Jackson Hole for a Warm-Weather Trip

Whether you're looking for cowboy charm or mountainside luxury in Jackson Hole—there's a perfect stay for you.

After the last skiers come down Rendezvous and Apres Vous Mountains in April, Jackson Hole, Wyoming ever so briefly experiences its spring shoulder season—which is quickly followed by the bustling summer months. It's at this point that the Western town goes through a distinct shift from one tourism peak to the next and winter sports turn into hiking, biking, and rock climbing; snowshoeing and cross-country skiing tours switch to wildlife safaris with potential sightings of black bears and grizzlies.

Summer in Jackson Hole is far from a well-kept secret. Travelers, understandably, are drawn to the mountain town this time of year. Weather-wise, June through September is ideal for exploring Grand Teton National Park and Yellowstone; with Jackson Hole as your basecamp, you can even see them both over the course of a single trip. The draw to the area is so strong, in fact, that in 2022, the peak of summer travel through Jackson Hole Airport surpassed the previous winter's apex. If you're planning a visit this summer, you'll want to book your accommodations soon, whether you want the five-star services of Caldera House or the adventure-focused amenities of Mountain Modern—there's a hotel for every type of traveler making their way to Jackson Hole.
