

Start your day with a European-style breakfast, including a house-made pastry and custom coffee creation at The Bistro, the property's Parisian brasserie style restaurant helmed by Gavin Fine and Fine Dining Restaurant Group. If you're here during ski season, it's time to hit the slopes—Jackson Hole Mountain Resort is just a short shuttle bus ride away. There's also plenty to do during the summer months, with the property's in-house outfitters available to arrange any kind of experience you're looking for, from fly fishing on Snake River to rafting, mountain biking and more.

When you get back to The Cloudveil after an epic outdoor experience, soak your sore muscles in the outdoor hot tub or heated pool, or hit the town square and shop 'til you drop. When the sun sinks behind the Grand Tetons, venture to the lobby for cocktail hour before making your way to The Bistro for a delectable Parisian-inspired dinner (don't miss the oyster bar, and the cocktail list is spectacular). If you've still got some gas left in the tank, head across the street to the Million Dollar Cowboy Bar—a Jackson Hole staple—for a nightcap (potentially several nightcaps at this lively bar) and line dancing before you hit the hay to recharge for another day in the great outdoors.
